- D. Individual applicants are asked to provide us with a personal resume or curriculum vitae.

- D. What are the project's objectives: who benefits and how?
- E. What is the project's development program and how are the goals to be reached?

- G. Please explain how you understand this project in relationship to the declared frame of reference of the Reid Trust? How does it fit within our parameters?

- H. Please provide the names and addresses of those who will supervise this project.
- I. Please provide a statement from these supervisors indicating how they relate this project to the frame of reference of the Reid Trust.
